Tickets All tickets are available online at springditch.com and will also be for available on the gate (**Cash Only**) for the same prices. Buy online for smooth sailing!

Bus Catch the Spring Ditch express from Beechy to the festival and back again! Travel is between the Telegraph Station on Ford Street direct to the festival.

Getting There: First bus leaves for Spring Ditch at 10:30am with following services in 45min to 1 hour intervals. **Getting Back:** buses returning to Beechworth start at 4:30pm with following services in 45min to 1 hour intervals up until 8pm. Tix at springditch.com or on the day in person. *If you drive out and end up having a few drinks, be a rad unit and get the bus back to town!

Cash / Eftpos Bring Cash! The internet on site is really dodgy! We'll have eftpos but it'll be very up and down, and at many times will just not work. Our bar and vendors will have eftpos in some cases, but there'll be raffles and a few other things that are strictly cash only. Bring cash for trip down memory lane and for a much smoother experience!

Water Bring Some! We'll have limited free water on site. There will be water on sale with our vendors, but save your dosh and pack a bit of H2O.

Bar The Madman's Gully Bar is fully stocked and ready for you. **No BYO Please!**

Food We've got some great food vendors on site, pack a picnic if you prefer though!

Parking Parking is available on streets only please. Once full, we have overflow parking available at Snowy's Paddock (31 Pioneer Rd. Stanley) which is very close. Throw \$2 in the bucket at the gate, which goes into the charity pool, and park up!

Picnic Rugs / Chairs / Comfy Stuff Bring it! Make yourselves at home. Set up a rad base camp. Prepare for all weather too, you never know!
